

BSCC Fundraiser Event Rules Sheet

***All shooters must wear eye and ear protection.**

*Only shotguns that are designed for clay shooting will be allowed on the course. That will include pump, semi-auto, or breach load guns. Shotguns designed for tactical application will not be allowed on the course.

*While moving around the course, all gun actions should be open and made safe. Guns must always be pointed in a safe position/direction and carried in a safe manner.

***No shooter will have any shells in their gun** unless they are at a shooting station and are in the process of calling "pull" for a shot. The gun muzzle must be over the rail of the station when the gun is being loaded.

*Only **TWO** shells are allowed in the gun at any one time.

*All shooters are asked to be aware of any unsafe issue. If an unsafe practice or situation is observed, any shooter has the right to call "cease fire" until the situation has been rectified. One of the range safety officers listed on the Team Score Sheet should be notified if a problem is observed.

*If any shooter has a gun or shell malfunction, the gun should be maintained in a safe position (pointed downrange) and a range safety officer should be immediately notified.

*If there is a trap machine malfunction or failure, a range safety officer should be notified immediately. If a situation arises where a trap machine cannot be immediately fixed or repaired, the remaining shots will be taken on station as a report pair from the remaining operational trap.

*If a clay breaks upon exiting the trap, the shooter can call "No Bird" and the clay can be re-presented.

*At the beginning of each Sporting Clays Station, each team can have **one** preview of the clay presentations at that station. **No additional "practice" presentations** will be thrown. Shooter rotations at each station are open to team selection. Clay presentations at each station will be report pairs and/or true pairs.

*Each team member must shoot their assigned shots. No team member may "fill in" or shoot another team member's shots.

***Any** observed safety violations will result in that shooter being removed from the course.
